The Otay Water District (District) will require the services of engineering consulting firm(s) to provide professional services in support of the Asset Management Program (AMP) for a period of three Fiscal Years (FY 2018 - FY 2020) on an as-needed basis, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$175,000. The Consultant will support the District in developing an improvement plan for the AMP that is consistent with industry best practices. The consultant should be familiar and proficient with the following applications utilized by the District; ESRI ArcGIS v.10.5 and InnoVyz InfoMaster v.2017.
