

ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

Sealed bids addressed to the Board of Directors, Otay Water District (District), will be received for the **CAMPO ROAD SEWER REPLACEMENT (CIP S2024)** at the office of the District, 2554 Sweetwater Springs Boulevard, Spring Valley, California 91978-2004, until **4:00 PM local time, on March 9, 2017**, and at that time bids will be publicly opened and read.

The general scope of work includes: construction of approximately 7,575 feet of 8-inch and 15-inch gravity sewer pipe; jack and bore of approximately 426 feet of 30" steel casing pipe and approximately 505 feet of 16" FPVC carrier pipe; open trench installation of approximately 147 feet of 30" PVC casing and 154 feet of 16" FPVC carrier pipe; abandonment of 11,657 feet of existing 8-inch and 10-inch sewer pipe; installation of 26 new manholes; reconnection of sewer lines and laterals; 8-inch waterline relocation; 36-inch RCP storm drain diversion; maintaining sewer service; restoration of pavement and striping; landscaping; replacement of concrete improvements; traffic control; erosion control; protection of existing utilities; testing and inspection; and all other work and appurtenances in accordance with the Contract Documents. The engineer's estimate is approximately \$7,200,000.

The District advises potential bidders that the project may be funded in whole or part with federal loan or grant funds through the California Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund, and, therefore, federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise regulations, Davis-Bacon prevailing wage requirements, and American Iron and Steel requirements apply to this project.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

- No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].
- No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at 10:00 AM on February 16, 2017 in the Otay Water District Board Room. The District is using BidSync, an online bid solicitation website, for electronic distribution of Bid Documents. Bidders must register online with BidSync at <http://www.bidsync.com> to participate in this procurement. There is no cost associated with registering. All documents and information related to this procurement are on the BidSync website under the bid name **Campo Road Sewer Replacement (CIP S2024)**. Once registered, bidders can view and download information regarding this procurement, including the bid and Contract Documents, as well as submit questions related to the bid and contract documents. The District will only respond to questions submitted on BidSync. A plan holders list, to be updated at least weekly, can be downloaded from the Otay Water District's website, Engineering Bids page at <http://otaywater.gov/engineering-bids/>.
